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

BRIDE

DIRECTIONS

Intermediate

SIZE

11 1/2-inch fashion doll

MATERIALS

- Crochet cotton size 10: 400 yds cream
- Steel crochet hooks sizes 7 and 10
- 2 size 1/0 snap fasteners
- 6 white 3.5mm pearls
- 1/2 of 2-inch plastic foam ball
- 3 inches fine floral wire
- 4 inches prestrung cream pearls
- 30 inches 1/4-inch-wide cream satin ribbon

- 5 green ribbon roses with pearls
- 4 white 1/2-inch ribbon roses
- 5 lily-of-the-valley floral sprigs with pearls
- 2 small flower sprigs
- 20 (6mm) pearls
- Tacky glue
- 13-inch square cream organza
- Tapestry needle

GAUGE

With steel crochet hook size 7, 8 sc = 1 inch; 8 sc rows = 1 inch

PATTERN NOTES

Weave in loose ends as work progresses.

Front lp (flp): Work in front lp only of indicated st.

Back lp (blp): Work in back lp only of indicated st.

Reverse shaping: The following 1-row example illustrates the method of reverse shaping: Ch 1, sc dec over next 2 sc, sc in next 3 sc, turn. To reverse shaping you will reverse the row to read: Ch 1, sc in next 3 sc, dec 1 sc over next 2 sc, turn.

WEDDING GOWN BODICE

Row 1: With steel crochet hook size 7, ch 31, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each rem ch across, turn. (30)

Row 2: Ch 1, [sc in blp of next sc, sc in flp of next sc] rep across, turn.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in blp of next sc, sc in flp of next sc, 2 sc in blp of next sc, *[sc in flp of next sc, sc in blp of next sc] twice, 2 sc in flp of next sc, [sc in blp of next sc, sc in flp of next sc] twice, 2 sc in blp of next sc, rep from * once, [sc in flp of next sc, sc in blp of next sc] twice, 2 sc in flp of next sc, sc in blp of next sc, turn.

Row 4: Ch 1, [sc in flp of next sc, sc in blp of next sc] rep across, turn.

Row 5: Ch 1, [sc in blp of next sc, sc in flp of next sc] rep across, turn.

Row 6: Rep Row 4.

Row 7: Ch 1, *[sc in blp of next sc, sc in flp of next sc] twice, 2 sc in blp of next sc, [sc in flp of next sc, sc in blp of next sc] twice, 2 sc in flp of next sc, rep from * twice, [sc in blp of next sc, sc in flp of next sc] 3 times, turn. (42)

Row 8: Rep Row 5.

Row 9: Rep Row 4.

Row 10: Rep Row 5.

Row 11: Ch 1, [sc in blp of next sc, sc in flp of next sc] twice, sc in blp of next sc, 2 sc in flp of next sc, *[sc in blp of next sc, sc in flp of next sc] twice, sc in blp of next sc, 2 sc in flp of next sc, rep from * 4 more times, [sc in blp of next sc, sc in flp of next sc] 3 times, turn. (48)

Row 12: Rep Row 5.

Left back

Row 13: Ch 1, [sc in blp of next sc,

sc in flp of next sc] 5 times, turn. (10)

Note: Decreased edge is the back pening.

Row 14: Ch 1, [sc in blp of next sc, sc in flp of next sc] 4 times, sc dec in blp of next 2 sc, turn. (9)
Row 15: Ch 1, sc dec in flp of next

2 sc, [sc in blp of next sc, sc in flp of next sc] 3 times, sc in blp of next sc, turn. (8)

Row 16: Ch 1, [sc in flp of next sc, sc in blp of next sc] 3 times, sc dec in flp of next 2 sc, turn. (7)

Note: Maintain pattern of flp and

blp on the rem rows.

Row 17: Ch 1, sc dec in blp over

next 2 sc, sc in next 5 sc, turn. (6) **Row 18:** Ch 1, sc in 4 sc, dec 1 sc

over next 2 sc, turn. (5)

Row 19: Ch 1, sc dec over next 2

sc, sc in next 3 sc, turn. (4) **Row 20:** Ch 1, sc in next 2 sc, sc dec over next 2 sc, turn. (3)

Row 21: Ch 1, sc dec over 2 sc, sc in next sc, turn.

Row 22: Ch 1, sc in next 2 sc, fasten off.

Center front

Row 1: With wrong side facing, sk 4 sc for underarm, attach cream cotton with a sl st in blp of next sc, [sc in flp of next sc, sc in blp of next sc] 9 times, sc in flp of next sc, turn.

Row 2: Ch 1, [sc in blp of next sc, sc in flp of next sc] rep across, turn.

Row 3: Ch 1, [sc in blp of next sc, sc in flp of next sc] twice, turn. (4)
Row 4: Ch 1, sc dec in blp of next 2

Row 4: Ch 1, sc dec in blp of next 2 sc, sc in flp of next sc, sc in blp of next sc, turn. (3)

Row 5: Ch 1, sc in blp of next sc, sc dec in flp of next 2 sc, turn. (2)

Rows 6-10: Maintain pattern of blp and flp, ch 1, sc in next 2 sc, turn. At the end of Row 10, fasten off.

Sk 12 sts at center front and rep Rows 3–10, reversing shaping.

Right back

Sk 4 sts for underarm, rep Rows 13–22, reversing shaping.

With right sides facing, sew shoulder seams.

SLEEVES (make 2)

Rnd 1 (Right side): Attach cream cotton at underarm, ch 1, work 36 sc

evenly sp around armhole opening, sl st to join in beg sc. (36)

Rnd 2: Ch 1, sc in same sc as beg ch-1, ch 1, sk 1 sc, [sc in next sc, ch 1, sk 1 sc] rep around, sl st to join.

Rnds 3-10: Ch 1, [sc in sc, ch 1, sk ch-1 sp] rep around, sl st to join in beg sc.
Rnd 11: Ch 1, sc in each ch-1 sp around, sl st to join in beg sc. (18)

Rnds 12–15: Ch 1, sc in each sc around, sl st to join in beg sc.

Rnd 16: Ch 1, [sc in next sc, dec 1 sc over next 2 sc] rep around, do not join, use a scrap of CC yarn to mark rnds. (12)

Rnds 17–24: Sc in each next 12 sc, do not join.

At end of Rnd 24, sl st in next sc.

Rnd 25: Ch 3, sl st in same sc, [sk next sc, sc in next sc, ch 3, sl st in same sc] rep around, fasten off.

SKIRT

Row 1 (Wrong side): With steel crochet hook size 7, attach cream cotton in opposite side of foundation ch of bodice, ch 1, sc in each ch across, turn. (30)

Row 2 (Right side): Working in back lps only for this row, ch 3, dc in next st, 2 dc in next st, [dc in next 2 sts, 2 dc in next st] rep across, turn. (40)

Row 3: Ch 3, dc in next 2 dc, 2 dc in next dc, [dc in next 3 dc, 2 dc in next dc] rep across, turn. (50)

Rnd 4: Ch 3, dc in next 3 dc, 2 dc in next dc, [dc in next 4 dc, 2 dc in next dc] rep across, sl st to join in top of beg ch-3. (60)

Rnd 5: Ch 3, dc in next 4 dc, 2 dc in next dc, [dc in next 5 dc, 2 dc in next dc] rep around, sl st to join in top of beg ch-3. (70)

Rnds 6–8: Ch 3, dc around, inc 10 dc evenly sp around, sl st to join in top of beg ch-3. (100)

Rnd 9 (Right side): Working in back lps for this rnd only, ch 3, dc in next 8 dc, 2 dc in next dc, [dc in next 9 dc, 2 dc in next dc] rep around, sl st to join in top of beg ch-3.

Rnds 10–13: Ch 3, dc around, inc 10 dc evenly sp around, sl st to join in top of beg ch-3. (150)

Rnds 14–16: Ch 3, dc in each dc around, sl st to join in top of beg ch-3.

Rnd 17 (Right side): Working in

back lps for this rnd only, ch 3, dc in each dc around, sl st to join in top of beg ch-3.

Rnds 18–24: Ch 3, dc in each dc around, sl st to join in top of beg ch-3.

Rnd 25: Ch 3, sl st in same dc, [sk next dc, sc in next dc, ch 3, sl st in same dc] rep around, join, fasten off.

Lower ruffle

Rnd 1: With bottom of skirt facing, attach cream cotton with sl st in rem free lp of Rnd 16 at center back, working in rem free lps, ch 1, sc in same st as beg ch-1, sc in each st around, sl st to join in beg sc, turn.

Rnd 2: Working in back lps for this rnd only, ch 1, sc in same st as beg ch-1, ch 3, sk next sc, [sc in next sc, sk next sc, ch 3] rep around, sl st to join in beg sc.

Rnd 3: Sl st into ch-3 lp, ch 1, sc in same ch lp, ch 4, [sc in next ch lp, ch 4] rep around, sl st to join in beg sc.

Rnd 4: Sl st into ch-4 lp, ch 1, sc in same ch lp, ch 5, [sc in next ch lp, ch 5] rep around, sl st to join in beg sc.

Rnd 5: Sl st into ch-5 lp, ch 1, sc in same ch lp, ch 6, [sc in next ch lp, ch 6] rep around, sl st to join in beg sc.

Rnd 6: Sl st to center of next ch lp, ch 1, sc in same ch lp, ch 2, dc, ch 5, dc in next ch lp, ch 2, [sc in next ch lp, ch 2, dc, ch 5, dc in next ch lp, ch 2] rep around, sl st to join in beg sc.

Rnd 7: Ch 1, sc in same sc as beg ch-1, 9 dc in ch-5 lp, [sc in next sc, 9 dc in next ch-5 lp] rep around, sl st to join in beg sc, fasten off.

Center ruffle

Rnds 1–7: Working in rem free lps of Rnd 8, rep Rnds 1–7 of lower ruffle.

Upper ruffle

Row 1: With bottom of skirt facing, working in rem free lps of Row 1 of skirt, attach cream cotton with sl st in center back lp, ch 1, sc in each st across, do not join, turn.

Rnd 2: Working in back lps only for this row, ch 2, hdc in same st as beg ch-2, work 2 hdc in each st across, sl st to join in top of beg ch-2.

Rnds 3–8: Rep Rnds 2–7 of lower ruffle.

NECKLINE & BACK OPENING TRIM

Row 1 (Wrong side): Attach

cream cotton with sl st in first st at bottom of back dress opening, ch 1, sc evenly sp up back opening, around neckline and down opposite back opening, turn.

Row 2: Ch 3, sl st in same sc, [sk next sc, sc in next sc, ch 3, sl st in same sc] rep around, fasten off.

Sew 2 snap fasteners to back opening of dress.

Glue 3 (3.5mm) pearls to lower end of each sleeve for buttons.

BOUQUET

BACK

Rnd 1: With steel crochet hook size 7 and cream cotton, ch 2, 5 sc in 2nd ch from hook, sl st to join in beg sc. (5)

Rnds 2 & 3: Ch 1, working in back lps only, 2 hdc in each sc around, sl st to join in beg hdc. (20)

Rnd 4: Ch 1, working in back lps only, [hdc in next hdc, 2 hdc in next hdc] rep around, sl st to join in beg hdc. (30)

Rnd 5: Ch 1, working in back lps only, [hdc in next 2 hdc, 2 hdc in next hdc] rep around, sl st to join in beg hdc. (40)

Rnd 6: Ch 1, working in back lps only, [sc in next sc, ch 3, sk 1 sc] rep around, sl st to join in beg sc, fasten off.

Cut plastic foam ball in half. Glue bouquet back to flat side of half plastic foam ball (cut edge). Glue 4-inch length of prestrung pearls to Rnd 6 of bouquet back. Cut 30-inch cream ribbon in half; holding both lengths tog, make a 4-loop bow and glue to center bottom of bouquet on plastic foam edge. Glue lily-of-the-valley sprigs at base of bow. Glue flower sprigs, green roses, white ribbon roses and 10 (6mm) pearls as desired over plastic foam. Attach wire to back of bouquet to loop over hand.

HEADPIECE

Row 1: With steel crochet hook size 7 and cream cotton ch 37, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each rem ch across, turn. (36)

Row 2: Ch 3, sl st in same sc, sc in next sc, [sc in next sc, ch 3, sl st in same sc, sc in next sc] rep across, fasten off.

Row 3: Working on opposite side

of foundation ch, attach cream cotton, rep Row 2, fasten off.

Sew short ends tog. Glue 10 (6mm) pearls evenly sp around.

VEIL

Row 1: With steel crochet hook size 10, attach cream cotton with sl st in any corner of organza material, ch 1, sc in same place as sl st, insert hook through fabric approx. #/8 inch from edge, sc evenly around (approx 8 sc per inch) 3 sides of fabric, working 3 sc in each corner to turn corner, at the end of 3rd edge, turn.

Row 2: Ch 3, sl st in same sc, sc in next sc, [sc in next sc, ch 3, sl st in same sc, sc in next sc] rep across 3 sides, fasten off.

Weave a length of crochet cotton through edge without crochet sts, pull to gather to measure 2 inches, sew to center back of headpiece on underside.

GROOM

DIRECTIONS

Intermediate

SIZE

12-inch male fashion doll

MATERIALS

- Crochet cotton size 10: 300 yds black
 125 yds white
 Small amount jade
- Steel crochet hook size 7
- 4 white 4mm shank buttons
- 5 black 10mm buttons
- 3 size 4/0 snap fasteners
- Sprig of baby's breath
- Tapestry needle

GAUGE

8 hdc = 1 inch; 5 hdc rows = 1 inch

PATTERN NOTE

Weave in loose ends as work progresses.

PANTS

Row 1: With black cotton, ch 41, hdc in 3rd ch from hook, hdc in each rem ch across, turn. (40)

Row 2: Ch 2, hdc in next 6 hdc, 2 hdc in next hdc, [hdc in next 7 hdc, 2 hdc in next hdc] rep across, turn. (45)

Row 3: Ch 2, hdc in each hdc across, turn.

Row 4: Ch 2, hdc in next 7 hdc, 2

hdc in next hdc, [hdc in next 8 hdc, 2 hdc in next hdc] rep across, turn. (50) **Rows 5 & 6:** Rep Row 3.

Rnds 7–10: Ch 2, hdc in each hdc around, sl st to join in top of beg ch-2, turn.

FIRST LEG

Rnd 11: Ch 3 (forms crotch), sk 24 hdc, hdc in next hdc, hdc in each hdc and ch around, sl st to join in top of beg ch-2, do not turn.

Rnds 12–38: Ch 2, hdc in each hdc around, sl st to join in top of beg ch-2, do not turn.

Rnd 39: Sl st in each hdc around, fasten off.

SECOND LEG

Rnd 11: Attach black cotton in next free hdc of Rnd 10, ch 2, hdc in each hdc around, ch 3 (form crotch), sl st to join in top of beg ch-2.

Rnds 12–39: Rep Rnds 12–39 of first leg.

With tapestry needle and length of black cotton, sew crotch sts closed.

WAISTLINE & BACK OPENING TRIM

Row 1: Attach black cotton at bottom back opening, ch 1, sc evenly sp up back, around waistline and down opposite back opening, turn.

Row 2: Sl st in each st around, fasten off.

Sew snap fastener to back opening at waist.

DRESS SHIRT

BACK

Row 1: With white cotton, ch 29, hdc in 3rd ch from hook, hdc in each rem ch across, turn. (28)

Row 2: Ch 2, hdc in each hdc across, turn.

Row 3: Ch 2, hdc dec over next 2 hdc, hdc in each hdc across to within last 2 hdc, hdc dec over last 2 hdc, turn. (26)

Rows 4–8: Rep Row 2.

Row 9: Ch 2, 2 hdc in next hdc, hdc in each hdc across to within last hdc, 2 hdc in next hdc, turn. (28)

Rows 10–14: Rep Row 2.

Row 15: Sl st in next 4 sts, sl st in next st, ch 2, hdc in next 19 hdc, turn. (20)

Rows 16–21: Rep Row 2.

Row 22: Ch 2, hdc in next 5 hdc, fasten off, sk next 8 sts of Row 21, attach white cotton in next hdc, ch 2, hdc in next 5 hdc, fasten off.

LEFT FRONT

Note: Left front is crocheted vertically.

Row 1: Ch 19, sc in the 2nd ch from hook, sc in each rem ch across, turn. (18)

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in each st across, ch 11, turn.

Row 4: Sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next 9 chs, sc in each sc across, turn. (28)

Row 5: Ch 1, working in back lps for this row only, sc in each st across, turn.
Rows 6-8: Rep Row 2.

Row 9: Rep Row 5.

Row 10: Sl st in next 3 sc, ch 1, sc in each rem sc across, turn.

Rows 11 & 12: Rep Row 2.

Row 13: Rep Row 5.

Rows 14 & 15: Rep Row 2.

At the end of Row 15, fasten off.

RIGHT FRONT

Rows 1–13: Rep left front, except all rows specified to be worked in back lps only are worked in front lps only.

Row 14: Ch 2, sk 1 sc, [sc in next 5 sc, ch 1, sk 1 sc] rep across, ending with sc in 6 sc, turn.

Row 15: Ch 1, sc in each sc and each ch-1 sp across, fasten off.

SHIRT RUFFLES

Row 1: Starting with right front, working from top edge downward and working in rem free lps of Row 12, attach white cotton, ch 1, sc in each rem free lp across, turn.

Row 2: Working in back lps for this row only, [ch 3, sk next st, sc in next st] rep across, fasten off.

Rep Rows 1 and 2 in rem free lps of Row 8 and Row 4.

Work the left front in same manner, starting at bottom edge instead of top edge.

With tapestry needle and length of cotton, sew side and shoulder seams of shirt.

BOTTOM TRIM

With right side facing, attach white

cotton, ch 1, working through both thicknesses of shirt and ruffles, sc evenly sp across entire bottom of shirt.

COLLAR

Row 1 (Right side): Attach white cotton at front edge, ch 1, work 30 sc evenly sp around neckline, turn. (30)

Row 2: Working in the back lps for this row only, ch 2, dc dec over the next 2 sc, 2 dc in each next 6 dc, dc in the next 12 dc, 2 dc in each next 6 dc, dec 1 dc over next 2 sc, dc in last sc, turn. (40)

Row 3: Ch 1, dec 1 sc over next 2 sts, sc in each st across to within last 2 sts, dec 1 sc over next 2 sts, turn.

Row 4: Sl st in each st across, fasten off.

Inner collar trim

With top of shirt and right side of collar facing, attach white cotton with sl st in first rem free lp of Row 1, sl st in each st across, fasten off.

SLEEVES (make 2)

Rnd 1: Attach the white cotton at underarm, ch 2, work 31 hdc evenly sp around, sl st to join in top of beg ch-2. (32)

Rnd 2: Ch 2, hdc in next hdc, hdc dec over next 2 hdc, [hdc in next 2 hdc, hdc dec over next 2 hdc] rep around, sl st to join in top of beg ch-2. (24)

Rnd 3: Ch 2, hdc in each hdc around, sl st to join in top of beg ch-2.

Rnds 4–7: Rep Rnd 3. Rnd 8: Rep Rnd 2. (18)

Rnds 9–13: Rep Rnd 3.

Rnd 14: Ch 2, hdc dec over next 2 hdc, [hdc in next hdc, hdc dec over next 2 hdc] rep around, sl st to join in top of beg ch-2. (12)

Rnds 15 & 16: Rep Rnd 3.

At the end of Rnd 16, turn.

Rnd 17: Ch 1, sc in each hdc around, sl st to join in beg sc, fasten off.

Sew 4 white buttons opposite buttonholes. Place shirt on doll.

JACKET

LOWER SECTION

Row 1: With black cotton, ch 59, hdc in 2nd ch from hook, hdc in each rem ch across, turn. (53)

Row 2: Ch 2, hdc in each hdc across, turn.

2 hdc, hdc in each hdc across to within last 2 hdc, hdc dec over next 2 hdc, turn. (45) **FIRST FRONT Rows 9–18:** Ch 2, hdc in next 5

Rows 5-8: Ch 2, hdc dec over next

Rows 3 & 4: Rep Row 2.

hdc, turn. (6) At the end of Row 18, fasten off.

BACK Row 9: Sk next 5 sts of Row 8 for

underarm, attach black cotton in next hdc, ch 2, hdc in next 22 hdc, turn. (23) Rows 10-18: Ch 2, hdc in each hdc

across, turn.

At the end of Row 18, fasten off. SECOND FRONT

Row 9: Sk next 5 sts of Row 8 for underarm, attach black cotton in next hdc, ch 2, hdc in next 5 hdc, turn. (6)

Rows 10-18: Ch 2, hdc in each hdc across, turn.

At the end of Row 18, fasten off.

With right sides facing, sew shoul-

der seams.

cotton in lower front corner, ch 1,

LAPELS Row 1 (Right side): Attach black

work 30 sc evenly sp to within shoulder seam, work 10 sc across back neck, work 30 sc evenly sp down opposite front, turn. (70)

Row 2: Working in back lps only, ch 2, hdc in next 29 sts, [2 hdc in next st, hdc in next st] 5 times, hdc in next

30 sts, turn. (75) Row 3: Ch 1, sc in next 6 sts, dc in

next 63 sts, sc in next 6 sts.

Row 4: Working across bottom edge of jacket through both thicknesses across lapel sections, sc in each st across entire bottom of jacket, fasten off.

Row 5: Working in rem free lps of Row 1 of lapels, attach black cotton, sl st in each st up front, around neckline and down opposite front, fasten off.

SLEEVES (make 2) **Rnd 1:** Attach black cotton at underarm, ch 2, 31 hdc evenly sp around,

sl st to join in top of beg ch-2. (32)

Rnd 2: Ch 2, hdc in each hdc around, sl st to join in top of beg ch-2. Rnds 3 & 4: Rep Rnd 2.

Rnd 5: Ch 2, hdc in next hdc, dec 1 hdc over next 2 hdc, [hdc in next 2 hdc, dec 1 hdc over next 2 hdc] rep around,

sl st to join in top of beg ch-2. (24) **Rnds 6–10:** Rep Rnd 2.

Rnd 11: Rep Rnd 5. **Rnds 12–15:** Rep Rnd 2.

At the end of Rnd 15, fasten off. TAILS (make 2)

First tail Row 1 (Right side): Working

attach black cotton in next sc, ch 2, hdc in next 16 sts, turn. (17) Row 2: Ch 2, hdc in each hdc across, turn.

across bottom of jacket, sk first 10 sts,

Row 3: Rep Row 2. Row 4: Ch 2, hdc dec over next 2

hdc, hdc in each hdc across to within last 2 hdc, hdc dec over next 2 hdc, turn. (15) **Rows 5–13:** Rep Rows 2–4. (9)

Rows 14–16: Rep Row 2. Second tail

Row 1 (Right side): Attach black cotton in same sc as last hdc on Row 1 of first tail, ch 2, hdc in next 16 hdc,

turn. (17) **Rows 2–16:** Rep Rows 2–16 of first tail.

Row 17 (Right side): Attach black bottom in outer edge of tail, ch 1, sc evenly sp around both tails, fas-

ten off. Sew snap fastener to front bottom corner of jacket. Sew 1 black button over snap fastener on outer edge of

jacket. Sew 2 black buttons evenly sp

on Row 1 of each tail.

Row 1: With jade cotton, ch 46, hdc in 3rd ch from hook, hdc in each

CUMMERBUND

rem ch across, turn. (45)

Row 2: Working in back lps for this row only, ch 2, hdc in each st across, turn.

Row 3: Working in front lps for

this row only, ch 2, hdc in each st across, turn.

Rows 4-7: Rep Rows 2 and 3.

At the end of Row 7, fasten off. Sew a snap fastener on ends, place around waist, snap in place.

BOW TIE

Row 1: With jade cotton, ch 3, sl st to join to form a ring, ch 1, 3 sc in ring, turn. (3)

Row 2: Ch 1, 2 sc in first sc, sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc, turn. (5)

Row 3: Ch 1, sk first sc, sc in next 2 sc, sk 1 sc, sc in last sc, fasten off.

Row 4: Attach jade cotton in opposite side of foundation ring of Row 1, ch 1, 3 sc in ring, turn.

Rows 5 & 6: Rep Rows 2 and 3. Cut a 16-inch length of jade cotton. Draw through center st of bow tie to

center of length; knot cut ends at center of bow tie. Place bow tie on doll; tie ends in a bow at center back under collar.

BOUTONNIERE

Row 1: Leaving a 12-inch length of jade cotton at beg, ch 13, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each rem ch across,

turn.

Row 2: [Ch 3, sc in next sc] rep across, fasten off.

With tapestry needle, thread rem length at beg on needle; weave through opposite side of foundation ch. Pull to gather; knot to secure. Tack a sprig of baby's breath to back of flower and sew flower to left lapel of

iacket. ≫

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
