

Easter Egg Rabbit

SKILL LEVEL

■■■□ EASY

FINISHED SIZE

5½ inches tall, excluding ears

MATERIALS

- Patons Be Mine super bulky (super chunky) weight yarn (1¼ oz/95 yds/50g per skein):
 - 1½ oz #63005 wuzzy white
 - ¼ oz #63420 furry rose
- Size I/9/5.5mm crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge
- Yarn needle
- Sewing needle
- White sewing thread
- Fiberfill
- 2 black 9mm shank buttons
- Stitch marker

GAUGE

Rnds 1–3 = 2 inches

PATTERN NOTES

Weave in loose ends as work progresses.

Join rounds with a slip stitch unless otherwise stated.

Do not join rounds unless otherwise stated; mark rounds with a stitch marker.

BUNNY

Body/Head

Rnd 1: With wuzzy white, leaving a short length at beg, ch 3, sl st to join in first ch, ch 1, 10 sc in ring. (10 sc)

Rnd 2: 2 sc in each sc around. (20 sc)

Rnd 3: [2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc] around. (30 sc)

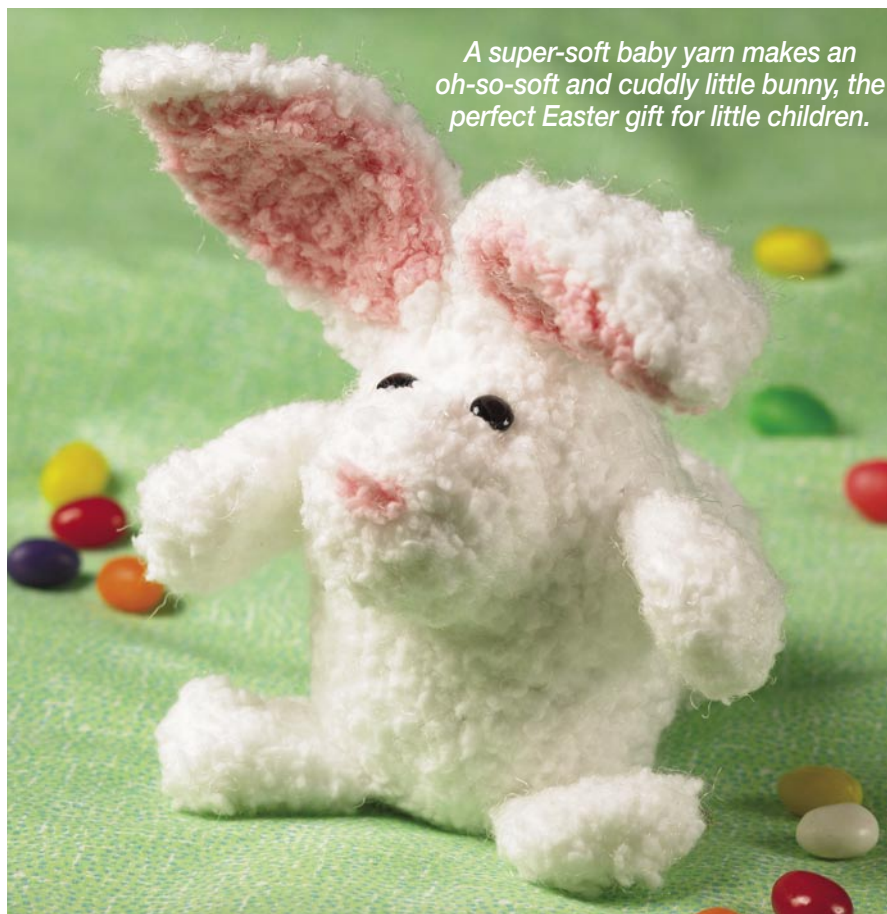
Rnd 4: Sc in each sc around.

Rnds 5–11: Rep rnd 4.

Rnd 12: [Sc dec (see *Stitch Guide*) in next 2 sc, sc in each of next 4 sc] around. (25 sc)

Rnds 13 & 14: Rep rnd 4.

Rnd 15: [Sc dec in next 2 sc, sc in each of next 3 sc] around. (20 sc)



A super-soft baby yarn makes an oh-so-soft and cuddly little bunny, the perfect Easter gift for little children.

Stuff Body/Head with fiberfill and continue as work progresses.

Rnd 16: Rep rnd 4.

Rnd 17: [Sc dec in next 2 sc] around. (10 sc)

Rnd 18: Rep rnd 17, sl st in next sc, leaving a length of yarn, fasten off. (5 sc)

Outer Ear

Make 2.

Row 1: With wuzzy white, ch 3, 2 sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next ch, turn. (3 sc)

Row 2: Ch 1, 2 sc in first sc, sc in each of next 2 sc, turn. (4 sc)

Row 3: Ch 1, 2 sc in first sc, sc in each of next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc, turn. (6 sc)

Row 4: Ch 1, 2 sc in first sc, sc in each of next 4 sc, 2 sc in last sc, turn. (8 sc)

Row 5: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

Rows 6–10: Rep row 5.

Row 11: Ch 1, sc dec in next 2 sc, sc in each sc across to last 2 sc, sc dec over next 2 sc, turn. (6 sc)

Row 12: Rep row 5.

Row 13: Rep row 11. (4 sc)

Row 14: Ch 1, [sc dec in next 2 sc] twice, turn. (2 sc)

Row 15: Ch 1, sc dec in next 2 sc, fasten off. (1 sc)

Inner Ear

Make 2.

Row 1: With furry rose, ch 3, 2 sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next ch, turn. (3 sc)

Rows 2 & 3: Rep rows 2 and 3 of Outer Ear. (6 sc)

Rows 4–8: Rep row 5 of Outer Ear.

Row 9: Ch 1, sc dec in next 2 sc,

sc in each of next 2 sc, sc dec in next 2 sc, turn. (4 sc)

Rows 10 & 11: Rep Rows 14 and 15 of Outer Ear. (1 sc)

Sew Inner Ear to center of Outer Ear. With front of Body/Head facing and Ears touching at center, sew row 1 of Ear to center top rnd 18 of Body/Head.

Muzzle

Rnds 1 & 2: Rep Rnds 1 and 2 of Body/Head. (20 sc)

Rnds 3 & 4: Sc in each sc around. At the end of rnd 4, sl st in next sc, leaving a length of yarn, fasten off.

Thread yarn needle with a length of furry rose, sew 2 long sts across rnd 1 of Muzzle.

Sew muzzle to front of Body/Head beg 1½ inches down from top of Head, stuffing with fiberfill as work progresses.

For eyes, sew black buttons to Head ½-inch apart, touching Muzzle.

Tail

Rnds 1–3: Rep rnds 1–3 of Body/Head. (30 sc)

Rnds 4 & 5: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 6: [Sc dec in next 2 sc, sc in each of next 4 sc] around. (25 sc)

Rnd 7: Sc in each sc around, sl st in next sc, leaving a length of yarn, fasten off.

Sew Tail to Body/Head 1 inch above beg rnd of Body, stuff Tail with fiberfill as work progresses.

Feet

Make 4.

Rnd 1: Rep rnd 1 of Body/Head. (10 sc)

Rnds 2–6: Sc in each sc around. At the end of rnd 6, sl st in next sc, leaving a length of yarn, fasten off.

Use photo as a placement guide. Do not stuff Feet with fiberfill. Sew 1 flattened edge of Foot to either side of Body about 2 inches down from top of Body/Head. Sew 1 flattened edge of Foot to either side of Body about 1½ inches above bottom of Body and 1¼ inches apart. ☞
